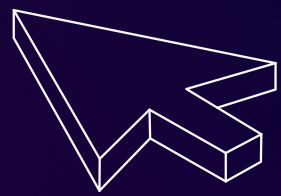

Recognizing the potential for AI platforms like GPT chat to generate and spread disinformation early on, we initiated a project addressing this issue.

This project unites experts from education, business, government, and the civil sector to devise solutions.



Key projects: Digital accessibility

Our team developed an innovative web checker that analyses websites in compliance with international WCAG 2.1 criteria.

Over 300 Governmental websites have been checked and adapted.

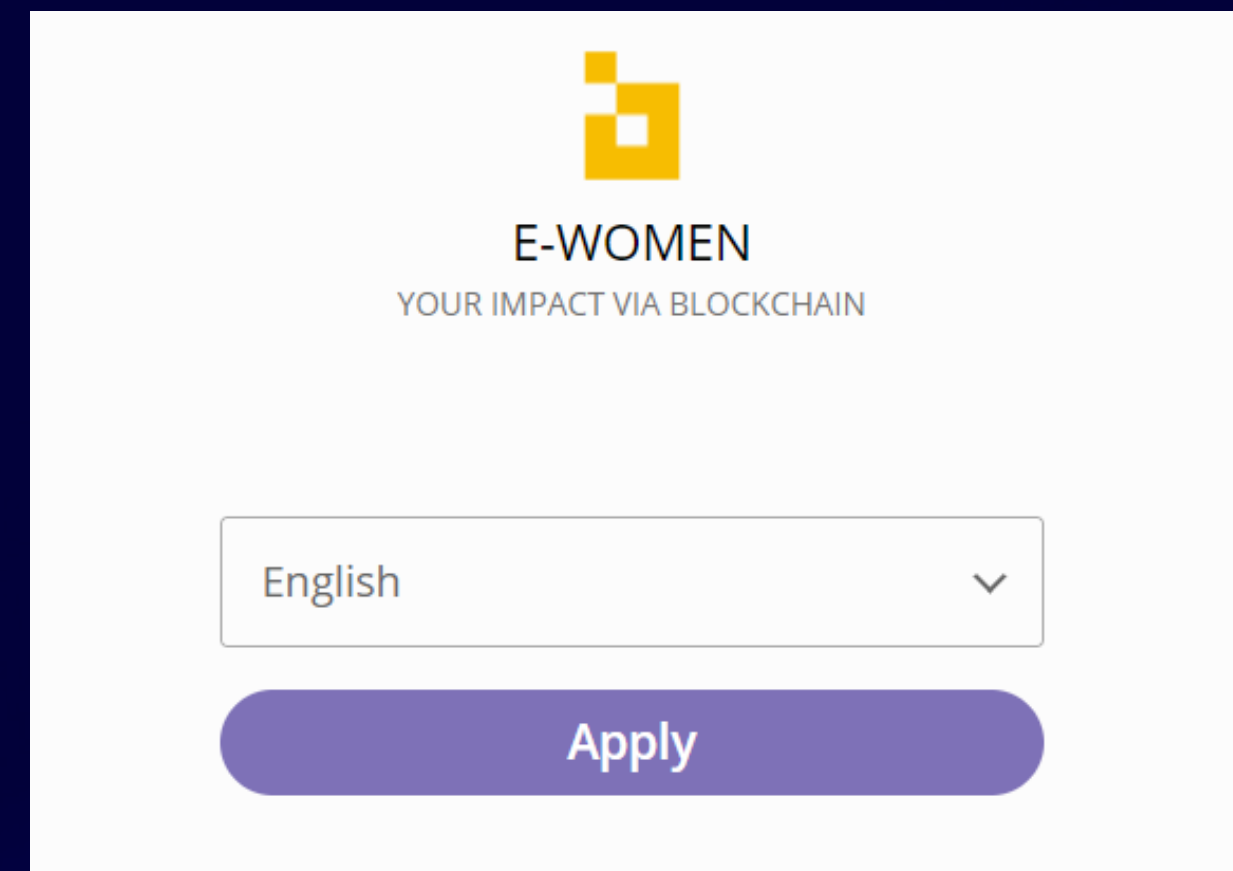

Key projects: E-Women

We developed an online platform where women can express their ideas for improving cities through e-petitions, by marking unsafe places on the map, and reporting sexist advertising.

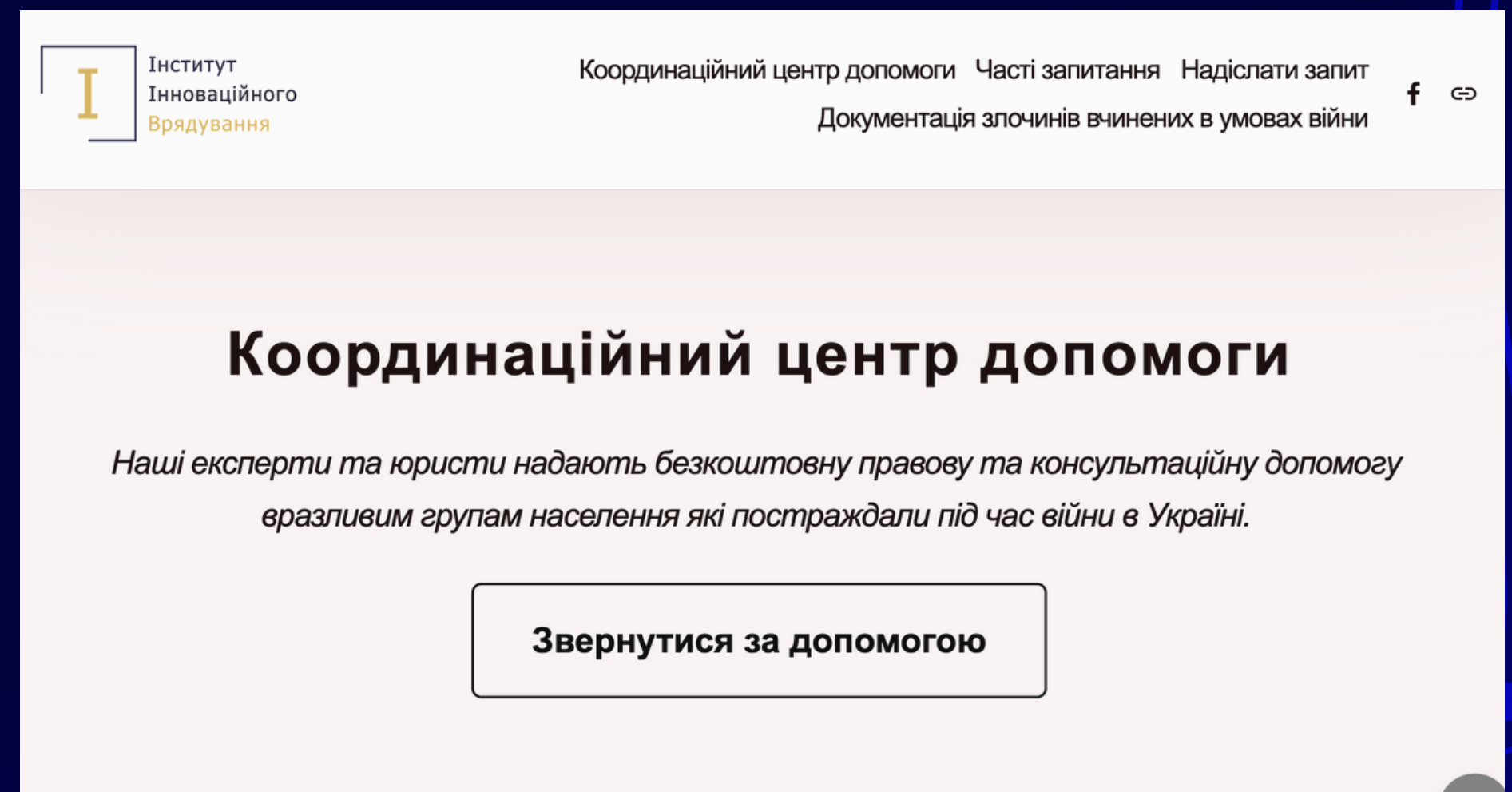


Key projects: Legal aid platform and documentation of war crimes

We developed a digital platform of legal aid for the most vulnerable groups of people affected by the war in Ukraine.

With the Office of the General Prosecutor of Ukraine, we work on the development of a unified strategy for documenting crimes committed by Russia.

More than 3000 people received support.



Key projects: EU Advocacy

Our advocacy team focused on advocating Ukraine's interests in the EU institutions, namely Council of the European Union.

About 30 meetings with various decision-makers and diplomats were organised. We called for immediate delivery of heavy weapons, oil and gas embargo, recognition of genocide in Ukraine and Russia's status as a terrorist state as well as EU candidacy status for Ukraine.



Key projects: Revealing Russian influence in Europe

We identified and described the activities of 360 pro-Russian lobbyists in key European capitals, and offered recommendations on how to counteract them.

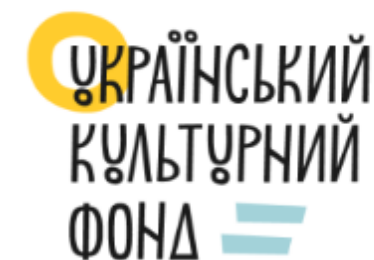

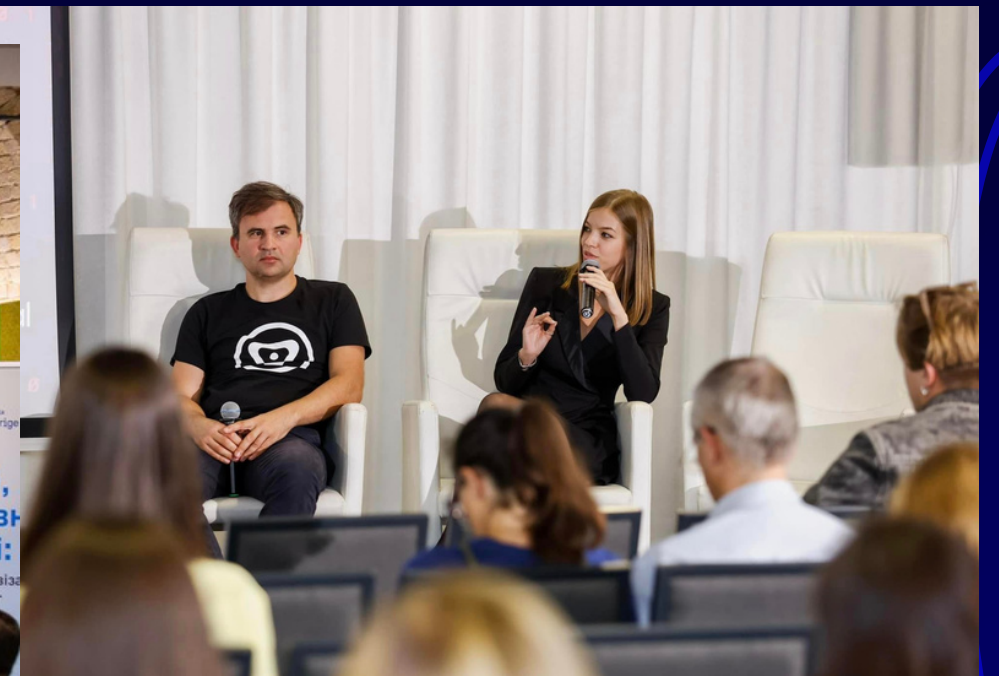
Workshops from Institute of Innovative Governance
